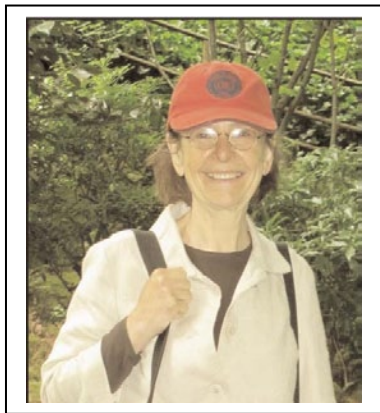

JANNEBETH ROELL co-founded and worked for more than fifteen years as a registered nurse at the Tobias Clinic in the Netherlands, an outpatient clinic where anthroposophical medical principals were applied. Since 1970 she has taught accredited home health courses based on anthroposophical ideals to doctors, nurses and lay people nationwide. Jannebeth co-founded the Anthroposophical Nurses Association of America, a nonprofit organization that supported certification courses in anthroposophical nursing for registered nurses and the public. After receiving her BFA in fine arts she gave art classes in clinics to a wide range of patients. In 2003 she moved to Portland, Oregon where she continues her art therapy from her own studio.
